

Teen Diplomatic Envoys Leadership Camp Strengthens Training Framework to Cultivate Youth Global Engagement

To foster international perspectives and cross-cultural communication skills among Taiwanese students, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs have jointly launched the Teen Diplomatic Envoys Leadership Camp. Built around an immersive camp-based training model, the program features a structured curriculum and hands-on activities to help students strengthen their English communication skills, understanding of global affairs, and critical thinking on public issues in real-world contexts—ultimately encouraging them to engage confidently on the global stage.

According to the K–12 Education Administration, the 2026 camps will be held respectively across two regions for five days. Through diverse courses and group-based projects, students will gain a deeper understanding of global issues in context, develop cross-cultural communication skills, and showcase their learning through final presentations and Q&A sessions. After the training, outstanding students from each region will be selected for the delegation that will set out

for an overseas visit during the winter break of 2027, engaging in firsthand exchanges to expand their international learning experiences.

Looking back at the 2025 training camp, students developed the ability to express their ideas in English and work together as a team through cross-cultural communication, discussions on global issues, and hands-on exercises. Following the camp, selected students formed a delegation to visit the United States, where they engaged in exchanges with local schools, government agencies, and overseas Taiwanese communities. Through these experiences, students gained first-hand exposure to diplomatic practice and multicultural interaction, and received high praise from host organizations.

The K–12 Education Administration stated that the Teen Diplomatic Envoys Program combines training and overseas visits to help students cultivate global communication competence and public engagement throughout their learning journey. In the future, the Administration will continue to refine its curriculum and training process to build a stronger foundation for Taiwanese youth to thrive internationally.
