The National Vocational Education Excellence Awards for the school year of 2018 was be held at the Activity Center of the Taipei Municipal Daan Vocation High School at 9:20 a.m. on Wednesday, May 22, 2019. There were 206 students from different learning backgrounds with outstanding achievements as well as teachers and administrative staff who were committed to vocational education gathering together to receive the awards from Wen-Chung Pan, Minister of Education. Meanwhile, the winners' teachers (parents) and school representatives were invited to attend the event.

The rotational host of the award ceremony for this school year was the Department of Education of the Taipei City Government. Out of a total of 406 candidates recommended by junior and senior high schools as well as administrative agencies in special municipalities, counties, and cities, 206 students, teachers, and administrative personnel with outstanding

achievements were selected in a prudent and objective manner by a review team composed of scholars and experts commissioned by the Department of Education of the Taipei City Government to receive the awards based on the principle of fairness, impartiality, and openness.
